The focus of the organization was and continues to be providing opportunities to people diagnosed with autism and developmental disabilities. Through loving care and support from the staff they are able to accomplish new things each day, often things no one ever thought possible. And with hard work CLASP now runs 12 homes and 9 apartments. It's in these homes where people live real lives, with friends, jobs, hopes and dreams... Just like you and I.
